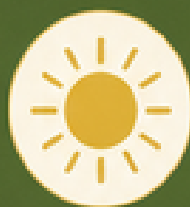

Gospel Message

Today's Gospel reminds us that every Christian has a mission. Jesus calls the twelve apostles, gives them authority, and sends them out to proclaim the Good News. Before He sends them, He first equips them. This teaches us that God never calls anyone without also giving the grace needed to fulfill the mission.

The apostles were ordinary people with many weaknesses, yet Jesus entrusted them with an extraordinary task. This shows that God does not choose us because we are perfect; He chooses us because He can work through us. Through our Baptism and Confirmation, each of us has also been called to be Christ's disciple and witness.

Jesus instructs the apostles to proclaim, "The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." The Kingdom of God begins wherever people experience God's love, mercy, forgiveness, and peace. Our families, workplaces, and communities should become places where Christ's presence is visible through our words and actions.

The Lord also says, "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." Everything we have—our faith, talents, time, and blessings—is a gift from God. Therefore, we are called to share these gifts generously by helping those in need, encouraging the discouraged, forgiving those who hurt us, and serving others with love.

Dear friends, today Jesus calls each one of us to continue His mission. Let us become His witnesses by living with faith, serving with love, and sharing His peace wherever we go. May our lives proclaim the Gospel so that others may encounter Christ through us.
