Gospel Message

Today's Gospel (John 6:60–69) presents a turning point in the ministry of Jesus. After teaching about Himself as the Bread of Life and declaring that His flesh is true food and His blood is true drink, many of His disciples found His words difficult. They said, “This saying is hard; who can accept it?” As a result, many walked away and no longer followed Him.

This Gospel reminds us that faith is not always easy. There are moments when the teachings of Christ challenge our understanding, our comfort, and our desires. In today's world, many people choose only the parts of Christianity that are convenient and reject the teachings that demand sacrifice, forgiveness, humility, and obedience. Yet true discipleship means trusting Jesus even when we do not fully understand.

Jesus did not change His message to make it easier. Instead, He turned to the Twelve and asked, “Do you also want to leave?” This question is addressed to each one of us. When we face suffering, unanswered prayers, family difficulties, illness, or disappointments, will we continue to follow Jesus? When the values of the Gospel conflict with the values of society, will we remain faithful?

At this crucial moment, Simon Peter gives one of the most beautiful professions of faith in the Gospel: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Peter did not claim to understand everything. He simply trusted the One who spoke. Faith is not having all the answers; faith is believing in the One who does.

This Gospel is especially meaningful when we approach the Holy Eucharist. The same Jesus who spoke these words gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is not merely a symbol; it is Christ's real presence among us. Like Peter, we are invited to believe and receive Him with faith and reverence.

Today, let us examine our hearts. Are there areas where we struggle to trust God? Are there teachings of Christ that we find difficult to accept? Let us bring these struggles to Jesus and ask for the grace of deeper faith.

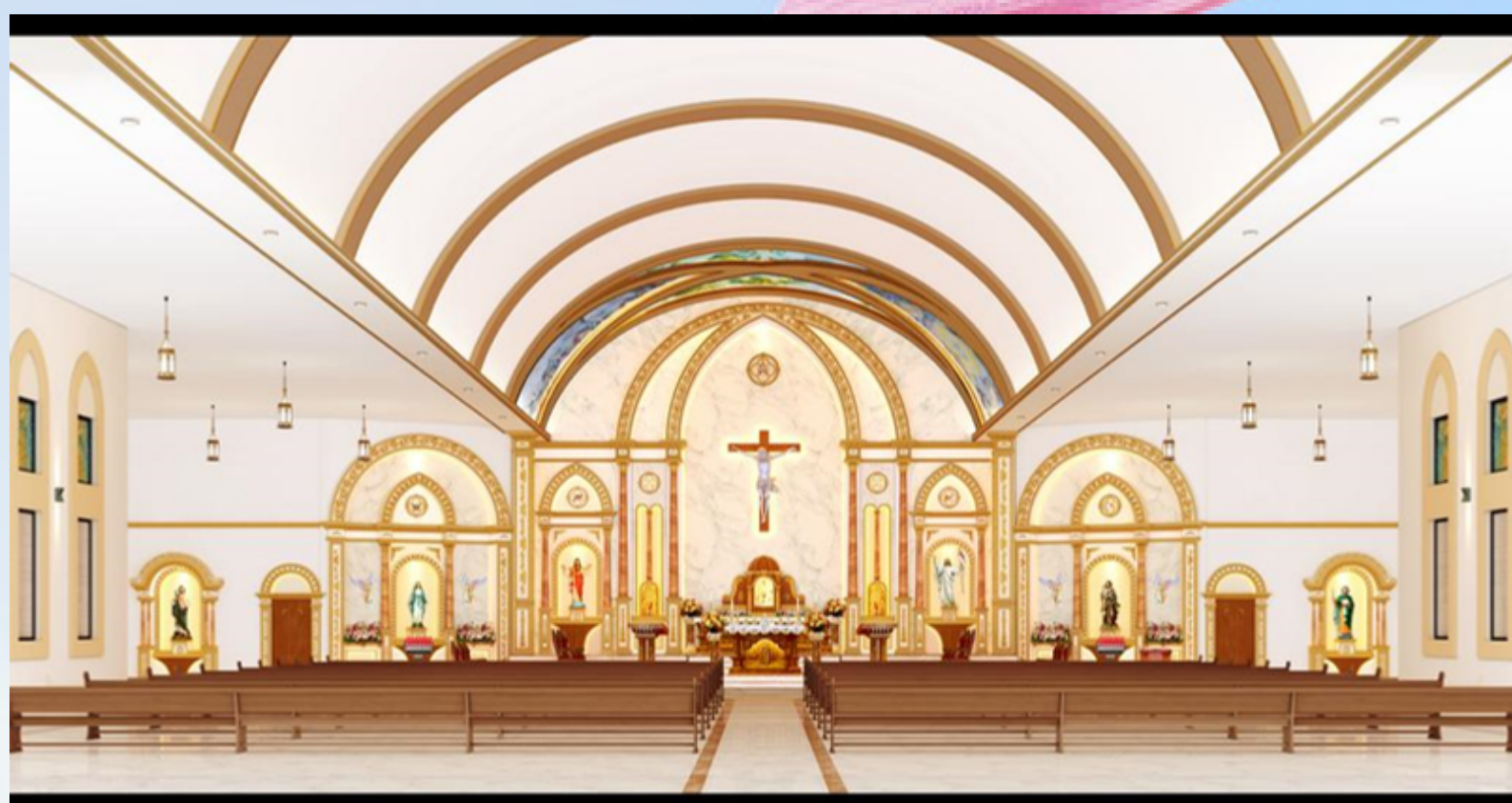

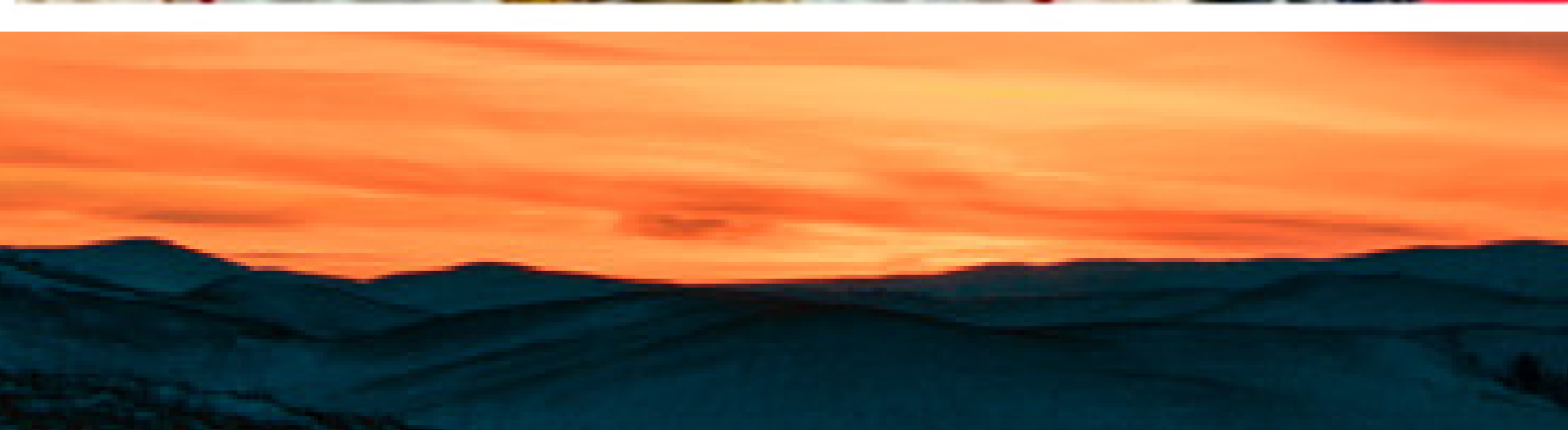
